



FLASH FORWARD

There is hardly any German Alternative Rock band that has such a great sense for stirring songs like FLASH FORWARD. Their sound is best described as a fusion of the power of Anberlin or The Used and the elegance of Dashboard Confessional.

After several years on tour FLASH FORWARD released their new studio album Revolt via Uncle M Music (Boyssetsfire, Apologies I Have None, Anti-Flag) in November 2017. The album marks a significant break in the band's history. In addition to its well-known irresistible guitar riffs and rousing hymns, Revolt presents a newfound profundity. FLASH FORWARD calls for a social change to which each individual has to contribute and criticize the constant selfish pursuit of self-optimization.

The four members of FLASH FORWARD know what they are talking about: over the last years they have worked without any break, they have stayed stubborn and have fought for their success. But as a young band, they know refinements are part of their growth. FLASH FORWARD charms the crowd with their neck-breaking live shows and their previous album releases enthused both press and blogs:

"Their outstanding mix of Billy Talent, Simple Plan, 30 Seconds To Mars as well as Bring Me The Horizon is unique in Germany" – The Pick Magazine.

The last LP Who We Are left their fans longing for more. FLASH FORWARD knew they had to reinvent themselves. With a new team and fresh impulses FLASH FORWARD refocused on their true talents: excellent song writing, a production that is in no way inferior to their American heroes and the courage to experiment with unfamiliar elements and influences.

"What might seem like a step backwards, for us it was rather a moment of pausing. In the winter we began to concentrate even more on ourselves and on acquiring a true Wagenburg mentality," says frontman Stefan, describing the band's starting point in 2017. "Revolt outlines our frustrations of the past few years - someone comes from outside and says you have to do this, you have to do that. We won't let someone bend ourselves anymore, but we go our own way with self-confidence".

The newfound maturity of the band also includes an increasing sense for the problems of our society. In contrast to the present egoism, the four demand solidarity and contribution of each individual for the benefit of all. The album cover shows a modification of Caspar David Friedrich's world-famous painting "The Wanderer above the Sea of Fog". The German icon raises a red flag into the sky on Revolt - a clear call for social commitment. In 2017, FLASH FORWARD finally arrived in their own scene with a message. Along with anthemic choruses and a perfect mix of alternative, indie and punk rock, it is their strongest and most varied album to date. Revolt fits to the maturity of FLASH FORWARD and will continue to rouse the clubs together with the English rock bands You Me At Six and Templeton Pek.
